Accountability

You are accountable to the Senior Leader with responsibility for Inclusion for all work undertaken.

Duties

- To assist in planning, teaching and assessing the differentiated curriculum and in developing, implementing and evaluating the individual education plans and individual behaviour plans, under the direction of Senior Leader for Inclusion, SENCO and subject teacher.
- Facilitate individual students or groups of students to access the differentiated curriculum, including assisting with the planning and preparation of learning activities under the direction of the subject teacher or SENCO.
- Contributes to the development, implementation and evaluation of Individual Provision Maps (IPMs)
- Under the direction of the teacher, SENCO, Senior Leader for Inclusion teach students in a small group or 1:1 learning activities in lessons and sometimes away from the main teaching area.
- To provide support to students with ADHD and ODD both in class and on a one to one or small group basis.
- To cascade details of strategies that have a positive impact on students learning and behaviour to other members of staff.
- Helps promote student's good behaviour and discipline through positive interactions with the students and participates fully in strategies agreed as part of any student's individual education or behaviour support plan, including physical intervention/activity.
- Shares with the teacher and other colleagues, issues of concern and positive feedback about the student's welfare and achievements.
- To carry out other reasonable tasks from time to time as directed by the Head.
- To work in accordance with the Academy's safeguarding policy
